The Intern will assist the Associate Producer with tasks including but not limited to casting, play reading and script analysis, dramaturgical research, and community engagement opportunities in preparation for the 2019-2020 Season. The Intern will also have the opportunity to assist in the rehearsal room on one of WaterTower's Main Stage productions. The Intern will learn the inner workings of the Box Office as well as assist the Company's Director of Finance & Administration as well as learn about fundraising, special events, publicity and marketing while assisting the Development and Marketing Departments.

While interns are assigned specific departments and mentors, they are also expected to work outside their chosen area of expertise. A well-rounded experience and networking opportunities, along with knowledge from the WTT staff.

Typical office hours are from 10am-6pm; however, *intern commitments and hours are flexible and the daily schedule will vary. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, have prior theatre experience and provide your own housing and transportation.*
